



## WHAT KIND OF KING IS JESUS?

MARK 11:1-11

**Jesus is the kind of King who loves you more than you can ever know.**

Jesus Christ...who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords. - 1 Timothy 6:14-15

On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords. - Revelation 19:16

[Jesus] is far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also the age to come. - Ephesians 1:21

At the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. - Philippians 2:10-11

But Jesus called them to him and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. - Matthew 20:25

It shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, - Matthew 20:26

...even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." - Matthew 20:28

Now when they drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples - Mark 11:1

and said to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. - Mark 11:2

"If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this? Say, 'The Lord has need of it and will send it back here immediately.'" - Mark 11:3

And they went away and found a colt tied at a door outside in the street, and they untied it. And some of those standing there said to them, "What are you doing untying the colt?" - Mark 11:4-5

And they told them what Jesus had said, and they let them go. - Mark 11:6

And they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks on it, and he sat on it. - Mark 11:7

And many spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut from the fields. - Mark 11:8

And those who went before and those who followed were shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! - Mark 11:9

"Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David! Hosanna in the highest!" - Mark 11:10

And he entered Jerusalem and went into the temple. And when he had looked around at everything, as it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the twelve. - Mark 11:11





When the large crowd of the Jews learned that Jesus was there, they came, not only on account of him but also to see Lazarus, whom he had raised from the dead. - John 12:9

And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, "Who is this?" - Matthew 21:10

### **Jesus Is a Humble King**

This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying, - Matthew 21:4

"Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your king is coming to you, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.'" - Matthew 21:5

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. - Matthew 11:28

Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. - Matthew 11:29

### **Jesus Is a King Who Sacrifices Himself for His People**

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! We bless you from the house of the Lord. - Psalm 118:26

The Lord is God, and he has made his light to shine upon us. Bind the festal sacrifice with cords, up to the horns of the altar! - Psalm 118:27

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God. - 1 Peter 1:18

### **Jesus Is a King Who Is Only Recognized at the Cross**

Then Pilate took Jesus and flogged him. And the soldiers twisted together a crown of thorns and put it on his head and arrayed him in a purple robe. - John 19:1-2

They came up to him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" and struck him with their hands. - John 19:3

And when the centurion, who stood there in front of Jesus, saw how he died, he said, "Surely this man was the Son of God!" - Mark 15:39

### **Jesus Is a King Who Tells the Truth**

Then Pilate said to him, "So you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice. - John 18:37

### **Jesus Is a King Who Changes the Old Ways of Religion**

And he entered the temple and began to drive out those who sold, saying to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of robbers. - Luke 19:45-46

And he was teaching daily in the temple. The chief priests and the scribes and the principal men of the people were seeking to destroy him, - Luke 19:47

but they did not find anything they could do, for all the people were hanging on his words. - Luke 19:48
