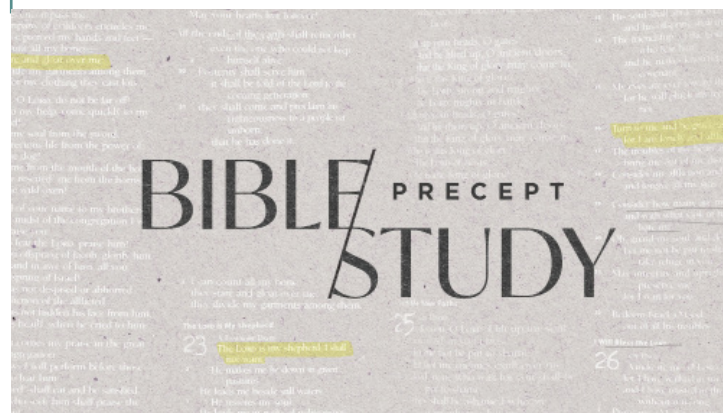

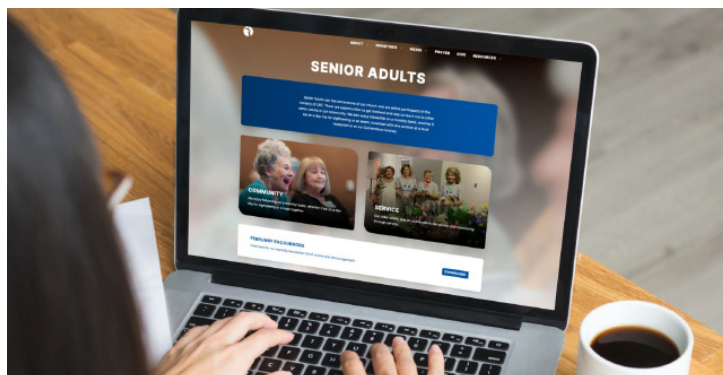
Bible Workshop

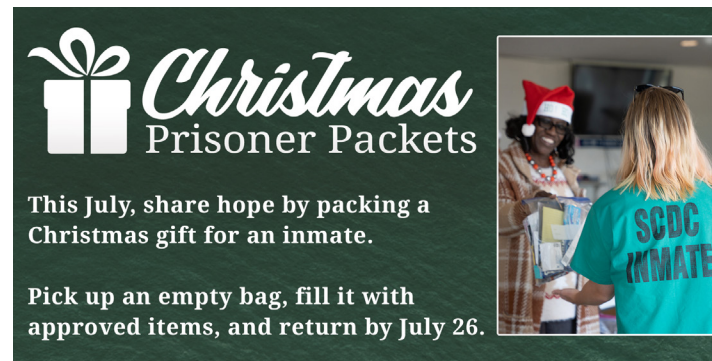
Man Morning
