SWAT' TEAM

What is SWAT Team?

SWAT Team is a group of Christian men (4 or 5) that commit to daily scripture reading, journaling and helping each other grow in Christ.

When do SWAT Teams Meet?

Each Friday, SWAT Teams will meet from 6:30-7:30am in the Fellowship Hall. Once a month, SWAT Teams will attend Man Morning and sit under pastoral teaching.

What do SWAT Teams read?

Each month, SWAT team leaders will share a simple daily reading plan. As we commit to reading God's Word together, we will grow deeper in our relationship with Him and strengthen the bonds of brotherhood within our team.

What "SWAT" means for us?

S – Study Scripture

W – Wrestle with the meaning

A – Apply the Meaning to your life

T – Talk about it with God (prayer/journal) and with others (Team/evangelize)

This should be the acrostic tool used for each SWAT Team member to journal through their daily reading.

What is the expectation of a SWAT Team Member?

- A goal of reading and journaling using the SWAT acrostic each day
- Taking a picture of your journal and sharing it with your team as a way of holding each other accountable
- Attending each Friday morning session prepared to share one or two major ways that God communicated to you through Scripture the previous week.
- Interact with your team in a supportive and encouraging way

I am interested in joining a SWAT Team, now what?

Consider the commitment carefully. If you seek a deeper connection with God and value Christian brotherhood and accountability, SWAT teams may be a good fit. Commitments require sacrifice, so review the form thoughtfully and, if married, include your spouse in this decision.

You will go through a 2-week orientation with a SWAT Team leader before being assigned to a team.
